1) EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- a) **Event Title:** 2017 CAMS NSW Motor Race Championship ROUND 5
- b) **Date:** SATURDAY 1ST & SUNDAY 2ND JULY, 2017
- c) **Venue:** Sydney Motor Sport Park, Ferrers Road, Eastern Creek NSW – the 3.9km Gardner (GP) circuit will be used.

2) ORGANISATION AND STATUS

- a) The event shall be held under the International Sporting Code of the Federation Internationale de l'automobile (FIA), the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), the Race Meeting Standing Regulations published by CAMS, the NSW Motor Race Championship Sporting Regulations as approved by CAMS, these Supplementary Regulations and any further Regulations and instructions to competitors that may be issued.
- b) The event shall be a NSW State Motor Race Championship meeting, with races for the invited;

g) The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any competitor in accordance with NCR 83.

6) **EVENTS** Races will be conducted for vehicles complying with regulations for the following categories as outlined in the 2017 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and 2017 CAMS NSW Motor Race Championship Sporting Regulations and appendices; Formula Vee (54), Sports Sedans (38),

SuperSports Cars (38), Improved Production Under 2L (47), Improved Production Over 2L (47), HQ Holdens, (54), Production Touring Cars (54), Superkarts (60), Formula Cars (38).

These races will be held in accordance with the 2017 CAMS Manual of Motorsport and the relevant Sporting & Technical Regulations for 2017.

- a) In order to maximise track time and racing laps for all categories, ARDC in consultation with CAMS reserve the right to combine events. This will be done with due consideration to the State Championships and the categories concerned. Any such combination will be advised in the race meeting schedule.
- b) Qualifying will take place on Saturday 1st of JULY 2017 before 12.30pm.
- c) The organiser reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59.

7) LICENCE & MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- a) Competitors must hold a CAMS PCC (Provisional Clubman Circuit) or higher grade licence.
- b) Competitors must hold a current CAMS-affiliated Car Club Membership

8) AUTOMATIC TIMING

- a) The organisers utilise an automatic timing system that requires all cars to be fitted with a Data 1 transmitter. Competitors must provide the transmitter. Transmitters are available from Dorian Industries, Factory 1, 29 Graham Court, Hoppers Crossing VIC, 3029. Phone: + 61 3 9931 1371.

9) PRIVATE PRACTICE AVAILABILITY

- a) Sydney Motor Sport Park is available for private practice on Friday 30th JUNE, 2017. The GST inclusive cost is \$180 per day or \$150 per day to members of the A.R.D.C.

10) GARAGE AND PADDOCK ALLOCATION

- a) The On-line entry system allows the hiring of garages and carports. ARDC members are given 1st offer of garages. Non-members Reserve a garage initially. (If you do receive a garage it is recommended that you bring your own padlock).

11) CREDENTIALS

All competitors should enter Sydney Motor Sport Park via Gate A off Ferrers Road where a car pass and tickets will be available for collection. Proceed through Gate A and down to the tunnel entrance where car passes and admit passes will be checked. Car passes will be required from **Friday morning**. Then continue through the tunnel to your designated space in the paddock or the support paddock.

Pit lane wristband passes can be issued at Friday practice and will be valid all weekend.

If you need to withdraw your entry you must advise the ARDC in writing **no later than 1700hrs on Monday JUNE 26TH, 2017 COB 1700hrs**. The ARDC will not consider refunds unless this requirement is strictly adhered to. A \$25.00 administration fee will be charged for **ALL** withdrawals. **If a competitor pays to attend Friday practice then suffers a mechanical failure which prevents him racing the ARDC will refund 50% of the race entry fee if advised in person or email or fax before 1700hrs Friday JUNE 30TH 2017.**

12) TARGETED SCRUTINY

All vehicles must comply with the relevant requirements for their category. Targeted scrutiny will be conducted at this meeting. The Chief Scrutineer for the event will determine which vehicles will be audited and those competitors will be advised of a time in which the audit will occur at event documentation scrutiny. A CAMS Vehicle Log Book must be presented.

All competitors must wear apparel in compliance with Schedule D of the CAMS Manual. All footwear, socks and gloves must comply with FIA 8856-2000 standard.

13) FUEL

Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

Mark Tierney 0419 511 517 Office: (03) 9706 5233. Unleaded racing fuel, leaded racing fuel, commercial unleaded and commercial E85 fuel are available. The maximum amount of fuel to be stored in each garage is 250 litres. Refuelling is not allowed in pit lane or in pit garages whilst participating in a race.

14) INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

15) PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

16) PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) July be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty (ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) July also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
