1) EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- a) Event Title: 2019 CAMS NSW Motor Race Championship ROUND 7 – State Championship
- b) Date: **SATURDAY 26TH OCTOBER & SUNDAY 27TH OCTOBER 2019**
- c) Venue: Sydney Motor Sport Park, Ferrers Road, Eastern Creek NSW – the 3.9 km Gardner (GP) Circuit will be used.

2) ORGANISATION AND STATUS

- a) The Event shall be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), the Race Meeting Standing Regulations, the NSW Motor Race Championship Sporting Regulations as approved by CAMS, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and instructions to Competitors that may be issued.
- b) The Event shall be a NSW State Motor Race Championship Meeting, with races for the invited;

5) CIRCUIT DETAILS

- a) Length: 3.9 km
- b) Direction: Anti - Clockwise
- c) Track Density: The maximum number of starters permitted in any race will be in accordance with CAMS guidelines as follows:
Formula Cars (38), Formula Ford (47), Sports Sedans (38), Improved Production U2L (47), Improved Production O2L (47), SuperSports (38), HQ Holdens (54), SuperKarts (60)

6) ENTRIES

Entries for this Event will be made via the ARDC On-Line Entry System;

Opening date:

- a) Early Discount Closing date: **FRIDAY 27TH SEPTEMBER COB 1700hrs**
- b) Late Entries: **FRIDAY 11TH OCTOBER 2019 COB 1700hrs**

The On-line Entry System allows the hiring of Garages and Carports. ARDC members are given 1st offer of Garages. Non-members Reserve a Garage initially. (If you do receive a Garage it is recommended that you bring your own padlock).

13) CREDENTIALS

All Competitors should enter Sydney Motor Sport Park via Gate A off Ferrers Road where a car pass and tickets will be available for collection. Proceed through Gate A and down to the Tunnel Entrance where car passes and admit passes will be checked. Then continue through the tunnel to your designated space in the Paddock or the Support Paddock.

Pit Lane wristband passes can be issued at Friday practice and will be valid all weekend.

If you need to withdraw your entry you must advise the ARDC in writing no later than 1700hrs on Monday 21ST OCTOBER 2019 COB 1700hrs. The ARDC will not consider refunds unless this requirement is strictly adhered to. A \$25.00 administration fee will be charged for ALL withdrawals. If a Competitor pays to attend Friday practice then suffers a mechanical failure which prevents them racing the ARDC will refund 50% of the race Entry Fee if advised in person or email or fax before 1700hrs Friday 25TH OCTOBER 2019.

14) TARGETED SCRUTINY

All vehicles must comply with the relevant requirements for their category. Targeted Scrutiny will be conducted at this Meeting. The Chief Scrutineer for the Event will determine which vehicles will be audited and those Competitors will be advised of a time in which the audit will occur at Event Documentation Scrutiny. A CAMS Vehicle Log Book must be presented. Competitors and Drivers must present their CAMS Affiliated Car Club Membership Card, CAMS licence and Log Book at Event Documentation Scrutiny.

All Competitors must wear apparel in compliance with Schedule D of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. All footwear, socks and gloves must comply with FIA 8856-2000 standard.

15) FUEL

Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

98Ron, Elf Race 102 and commercial E85 fuel are available via bowser at all times. The bowsers accept all credit cards.

The maximum amount of fuel to be stored in each garage is 250 litres. Refuelling is not allowed in pit lane or in pit garages whilst participating in a race or session. Any refuelling done outside this period, must be done in the following manner;

16) INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

17) PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

18) ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day.

Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
